PART III: PROGNOSTICS OF THE WEATHER BETWEEN 1200UTC MARCH 19 AND
1200UTC MARCH 20, 2024.

LOCALLY A FEW SHOWERS EXPECTED.

WIND: NE TO E, WITH SPEED UP TO 40KM/H, GUSTS UP TO 55KM/H (6-7BFT).

VISIBILITY: IN GENERAL: 10KM. IN SHOWERS: 5 - 8KM.

OCEAN WAVE DIRECTION AND HEIGHT NORTH OF 08 NORTH:

NE TO E / UP TO 2.7 METERS.

SWELLS: UP TO 2.2 METERS.
