BRIEF HISTORY

- The Caribbean Maritime Institute (CMI) officially became the Caribbean Maritime University (CMU) on World Maritime Day, September 28, 2017, at an official Charter Day Ceremony held at the National Arena in Kingston.
- The Government of Jamaica, by an Act of Parliament granted the Institution University status to confer degrees, awards, certificates, diplomas and other academic distinctions.
- The Institution was established in 1980 with 30 students. By 2007, enrolment had increased to 300 students. Since then, the number of students enrolled at the CMU has reached as high as 5,000.
- CMU is the first specialised public University and the only International Maritime Organization (IMO)-recognised University in the English-speaking Caribbean.
- The University has a Chairman, Professor Gordon Shirley, and a President, Professor Andrew Spencer.
