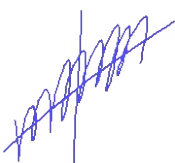

The guidelines as established in this "Maritime Security Instruction no. 2025/01(revision 1)" are issued in accordance with the provisions of art. 8 paragraph 4 in conjunction with art. 9 paragraph 3 of the Maritime Security Act. S.B. 2004 no. 90.

Declaration of Security (DoS)

The DoS in the International Ship and Port Facility Security Code (the ISPS Code) is a form that sets out the security measures and responsibilities between a ship and a port facility, or between a ship and another ship in situations where enhanced security measures are needed.

The DoS procedure is established in accordance with the Maritime Security Act (S.B. 2004 no. 90) considering the provisions of paragraph 5 part A and B of the ISPS Code and paragraph 2.7.3 of the Guide to Maritime Security and the ISPS Code.
