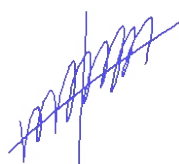
Pursuant to the ISPS Code Part A, paragraph 15.4, the PFSA must be reviewed periodically and updated where necessary to ensure the effectiveness of the PFSA.

- In accordance with the articles 9.2 a, 9.2 d, and 25 jo. 27 of the Maritime Security Act (S.B. 2004 no. 90) and the ISPS Code, part A, paragraph 15 as well as ISPS Code part B, paragraphs 1.16 and 1.17, a general review of the PFSA will be conducted annually and submitted to the designated authority for approval within thirty calendar days after completion.
- The comprehensive review of the PFSA should be carried out eight months before the expiry of the port security certificate and submitted to the designated authority for approval within thirty calendar days after completion.

In accordance with paragraph 16.59 part B of the ISPS Code and paragraphs 2.8.31, 2.8.32 of the Guide to Maritime Security and the ISPS Code the PFSA must be reviewed within thirty calendar days following changes to:

- the physical infrastructure of the port facility;
- the nature of the activities or use of the port facility;
- the relevant threat assessment or security risks;
- after a serious security incident; and
- renewed ownership or operational management of the port facility.

In accordance with Part A, paragraph 16 of the ISPS Code and with reference to paragraph 2.8.37 of the Guide to Maritime Security and the ISPS Code, an amended PFSP must be submitted to the Designated Authority for approval within thirty calendar days based on the revised and approved PFSA.
